

THE NEEDS OF THE VICTIMS

THE NEED FOR INFORMATION:

- Existing services and rights
- The judicial system
- The victims obligations (cooperating with police, testifying)



THE NEED TO BE HEARD WITHIN THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM:

- To be informed about the progress of the file
- To be consulted and heard at all of the stages (trial, sentence, conditional release)
- To be treated with courtesy



THE NEED FOR PROTECTION:

- Information on prevention methods
- To be able to relocate
- Protection by the police
- To know the date their aggressor will be released

THE NEED FOR PSYCHO-SOCIAL INTERVENTION:

- An intervention based on the experiences of each person
- An intervention that takes into account the type of aggression
- In certain cases a specialized therapy (phobias...)



THE NEED FOR PROMPT ASSISTANCE:

- Listening
- Assistance to relocate
- Financial assistance
- Accompaniment [Court, hospital]
- Referral to an appropriate organization
- Technical assistance



THE NEED FOR REPARATION:

- Reimbursement for financial loss
- Professional help for psychological trauma.
- Medical assistance to regain physical health


