Students take part in individual and group workshops that cover a variety of issues such as addictions and health, education and employment, social skills, violence, intimidation and conflict.

Students have the chance to:


- reflect on their thoughts & feelings

## Adaptive

**YES** workers are trained to help youth understand their issues and dig deeper into their motivations. Students referred to YES spend part of each day maintaining their academic work so they do not fall behind while they are out of their regular classroom.

## Responsive

**YES** responds to the issues affecting our Cree youth by understanding their need to be guided through activities that connect to the Cree experience.



## Flexible

Not every solution works for every youth. Our workers are trained to consider each student's goals and objectives first. Students are then placed in a 3 to 5-day program aimed at improving their journey and increasing their success in the school environment.
